Clinical Support Workers Vote for Strike Action




This month, Wirral CSWs have voted 99% in favour of strike action after their employer refused to match the deals won in other employers across the North West. CSWs and healthcare assistants in the region have won up to £17,000 in backpay after years of working above their band.


BETTER JOB SECURITY- Union members have more secure employment than non-union workers.
