you, your branch or committee can take...

DAY 1

Visit our website to learn more about what UNISON Northwest are doing to tackle VAWG and look at our resources.

DAY 2

Share the VAWG Strategy and Charter with your UNISON branch, colleagues, employer, friends, family and in your community.

DAY 3

Send a letter to your MP & ask for their support in securing fully funded support services. Visit the campaign tools section on our website.

DAY 4

Write to your employer asking them to sign the UNISON VAWG Charter. Your Councillor can assist, visit the campaign tools section on our website.

DAY 5

Donate or volunteer to charities and local women's shelters who work to combat gender-based violence. Our interactive maps on our website shows your nearest organisation .

DAY 6

Discuss with colleagues the need to report all violent and abusive incidents and how you report them to your employer.

DAY 7

Obtain your employer's Domestic Abuse, Violence and Aggression at work policy or start discussions about creating one.

DAY 8

Employers have a duty to take preventative steps against sexual harassment at work. Visit the website for resources.

DAY 9

Sign up to undertake further UNISON training on tackling VAWG. Visit the learning section on our website.

DAY 10

Familiarise yourself with UNISON's Migrant Care Worker Charter on our website, which campaigns to support migrant women in challenging abuse .
